


History

Breast Cancer Facts

- 1 in 8 women in the US will be diagnosed with invasive breast cancer and 2% of men.
- African American women diagnosed with breast cancer have a 42% higher mortality rate than the comparable rate for Caucasian women due to late stage diagnosis.
- Triple negative breast cancer is more Often diagnosed in African American women.
- Men can get breast cancer too. About 2% or estimated 2,650 men in 2021 will be diagnosed with invasive breast cancer in the U.S. (1 out of 833 men).
- There will be more than 281,550 invasive and new cases 49,290 non-invasive in 2021.
